	07.103	Student Academic Appeals Policy. Each Institution shall adopt a policy on academic appeals and establish a procedure for students to file academic appeals.		
	07.104	Student Conduct and Discipline Policy. Students are expected and required to obey all federal, state, and local laws, and institution policies and directives. Each Institution shall adopt a policy concerning student conduct and discipline, which includes a summary of laws		

policies that are unique to student employees. Students employed by the System Administration or an Institution shall also be required to comply with the same employment policies as other System Administration or Institution employees.

- 07.110 <u>Admissions Policies</u>. Each Institution shall adopt admissions policies consistent with admission standards set by the Board and publish them in a student publication.
- O7.111 Policy on Tuition and Fees. Each Institution shall adopt policies on student tuition and fees that comply with federal and state law, these Regents Rules, and relevant Board Orders. Each Institution shall publish current tuition and fee information in a student publication.
